Nationally Recognised Training

This course includes the nationally recognised unit of competency TLIC4006 Drive a multi combination vehicle, which is required to upgrade your licence to MC class with TMR Our MC Courses are designed in consultation with TMR and industry professionals and will ensure you are job ready and confident when you get you licence.

How much theory is involved?

You will be required to do some at home study prior to attending your theory class. There will be some reading and writing involved in this course. You will need to have literacy and numeracy skills to be able to complete workplace forms such as run sheets, logbooks, and pre-start checklists. You'll need to have reading skills to be able to read maps and route planning. An LLN test will conducted prior to the theory session to determine of you will require any additional support. If you think you might need some help with this, talk to us prior to enrolling.

Package deals

Additional training may be required (at an additional cost to you) to achieve competency and there is no guarantee of a successful assessment. To be eligible for a Multi Combination Licence you need to have held a HR or HC licence for a minimum of 12 months consistently.

Medical Certificates

It is your responsibility to ensure that your medical certificate (if required) is up to date and current for the type of vehicle you are driving (MC). If you require a medical certificate for driving, please check this prior to coming for your practical sessions as no refunds will be given.

Cancellation policy
